The High Commission of India, in London, invites online applications for the following scholarship scheme of ICCR (Indian Council for Cultural Relations) from UK nationals to study in Indian Universities/Institutes for the academic year 2023-24:

AYUSH SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME 2023-24

The scholarship scheme is for pursuing Under Graduate courses [BAMS, BSMS, BUMS, BAMS, Bsc(Yoga) & BA(Yoga Shastra)]; Post Graduate courses [MD in Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani/ Homeopathy]; and Ph.D. in Ayurveda / Unani in India under the AYUSH Scholarship Scheme.

The Last Date for submission of application on A2A Scholarship Portal for AYUSH Scholarship Scheme is May 31, 2023.

How to Apply:

(1).

- (1). Online Applications may please be submitted through the *A2A Portal*. Procedures and norms governing the scholarship scheme are given on the following link: www.a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in.
- (2). Candidates are advised to go through ICCR's instructions and guidelines carefully before filling up the online application form. These instructions/guidelines are available on the A2A Portal.
- (3). For the selection of a University/Institute and Course, applicants are advised to exercise due diligence, and carefully research in a dedicated manner on the specific admission criteria laid down by various Universities for each subject. Applicants must ensure that they submit all relevant documentation as required by the Universities/Institutes in addition to basic certificates mentioned in the application form. For this, they may refer to the Universities Handbook / University Grants Commission's website (<https://www.ugc.ac.in>) and the concerned institute's website for eligibility criteria.
- (4). Applicants will have the option to apply to Three (3) Universities/ Institutes, setting their preferred order of study, on the A2A Portal.

How to submit an application: Applicants should submit a "Hard Copy" of the application (along with all enclosures) uploaded online by them on A2A Portal, to the Education Wing, High Commission of India, London for consideration for Scholarship on or before **June 02, 2023**.

Please Note:

1. Applicants should have attained the age of 18 years at the time of admission in Indian Universities / Institutions.
2. The medium of teaching will be English or Hindi.
3. The allocation of University will be subject to availability of seat. If no seats are available in the choice of University given by the candidate, the allocation of University will be done by the Ministry of AYUSH in another University as per the availability of seats.
4. The application will be processed only for the course applied for by the candidate. No request for the change of course will be entertained later.
5. No request for transfer of University will be entertained once the admission is confirmed.
6. Candidates applying for this scholarship scheme should visit the website of the respective University/ Institution for details of the courses offered, eligibility criteria and general information about the University/ Institution.
7. Translated version of documents (into English) should be provided where original documents are in a language other than English, for applications to be considered.
8. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected by the Universities. Therefore, students are advised to thoroughly check their applications and attach requisite documents before submission of the application.
9. Submission of incorrect information or incomplete application forms by any candidate may result in forfeiture of the candidature/scholarship at any stage. No review will be considered in such cases.
