

## Undertaking by OCI applicant regarding Indian voter ID etc

To

I, \_\_\_\_\_, Current PP No.: \_\_\_\_\_ (and former Indian Passport No. \_\_\_\_\_ if applicable) understand the process of OCI registration and also understand that *the OCI Cardholder is not entitled to vote, be a member of Legislative Assembly or Legislative Council or Parliament, cannot hold Constitutional posts such as President, Vice President, Judge of Supreme Court or High Court etc. as specified in section 7B(2) of The Citizenship Act, 1955. The OCI Cardholder shall not be entitled for appointment to public services and posts in connection with the affair? of the Union or of any State except for appointment in such services and posts as the Central Government may, by special order, in that behalf specify. Further, the OCI Cardholder cannot acquire agricultural land or farmhouse or plantation properties in India.*

2. I, therefore, understand that I am not entitled to hold voter ID card, Ration card or any such documents which only Indian Citizens are entitled to hold. I hereby declare that I have surrendered all such documents which are entitled for Indian Citizens only including Voter ID card and Ration Card.

3. In case if authority finds that I continue to hold such documents or misrepresented or suppressed material facts, then necessary action can be initiated against me which may also include cancellation of my OCI Card and blacklisting for any future travel to india.
